

Model Number Nomenclature (does not apply to Specialty Merchandisers):



Tyler display merchandiser model numbers can be a confusing mix of letters and numbers. However, by understanding the order of these characters and their meaning, you can better identify the product's characteristics, and therefore what the equipment is designed to do. The above example identifies the syntax and meaning (in parentheses) of the elements that make up a model number. The legend below shows a categorical breakdown of the elements that define the syntax.

Product Line (Lead index number)

- N** = NSF / ANSI rated (2001-current)
- P** = Alpine Series models (2006-current)
- L** = Original Advantage Series (1996 - 2001)

Merchandising Levels (and service glass)

- 1-7** = Number of decks (shelves + bottom tray)
- (No number)** = Bottom tray only
- L** = Lift Glass (service merchandisers)
- F** = Fixed Glass (service merchandisers)
- V** = Vertical Glass (service merchandisers)

Product category (and Service Glass Style)

- M** = Meat
- D** = Dairy / Deli
- P** = Produce (packaged or bulk)
- F** = Frozen Foods; Fish (service)
- C** = Low Temp Ice Cream
- T** = Twin Temperature
- B** = Bakery (service merchandisers)
- H** = Hot (service merchandisers)
- L** = Low temp (service merchandisers)
- N** = Normal temp (glass door merchandisers)

Secondary Features

- G** = Glass Front; Glass Doors
- HP** = High Performance / TC Coil
- HPAC** = Airewave™ HP w/dual air curtain
- L, M, H** = Low, Medium, or High Front
- 2-5** = No. of Doors (glass door merchandisers)
- E** = Island End
- N, W, J** = Narrow, Wide, or Jumbo Island
- R** = Rear Feed; Remote (service)
- RL** = Rear Loading Roll-in
- FL** = Front Loading Roll-in
- S or SC** = Self-Contained Refrigeration
- D or N** = Dry Goods (non-refrigerated)
