

## Installing UltraSite32 on PCs Using Non-English Versions of Windows

### Overview

UltraSite32 may be installed on any PC running Windows 98 or above, regardless of language. However, when installing on a PC that is not running the U.S. English or International English versions of Windows, UltraSite32's installation program does not properly register the file DAO350.DLL, a driver necessary for the operation of the UltraSite32 database. In order for UltraSite32 to run properly on non-English versions of Windows, the DAO350.DLL file must be manually registered. This technical bulletin explains how to register this DLL.


### Manually Registering DAO350.DLL

1. First, you must locate the files DAO350.DLL and REGSVR32.EXE on your computer's hard disk using Window's "Find" feature.

**Windows 2000/XP:** Click the Start button, then from the Start Menu, select **Search > For Files or Folders**. Windows Explorer will open, and the Search pane will open in the left part of the window (pictured, left). Note: XP users may be prompted to specify what to search for — select the "All files and folders" option when prompted. In the "All or part of the file name" field, type:

**regsvr32.exe, dao350.DLL**

and select "Local Hard Drive C:" from the "Look In" drop-down list. Click the Search button.



**Windows 98:** Right-click the Start button, and select "Explore" from the pop-up menu to open Windows Explorer. From the toolbar at the top of the explorer window, select Tools > Find > Files and Folders. You will be presented with a Search pane like the one pictured at right. In the "All or part of the file name" field, type:

**regsvr32.exe, dao350.DLL**

and select "Local Hard Drive C:" from the "Look In" drop-down list. Click the Search button.

2. Windows will search for two files, regsvr32.exe and dao350.dll, and return a list of all locations where it finds these files. In the search results, left-click and hold down the left mouse button over the file name dao350.dll. Drag it until the file name overlaps the file name of the regsvr32.exe file (note: if multiple versions of regsvr32.exe were found, drag

dao350.dll over the one located in the Windows system directory, usually \windows\system32 or \winnt\system32).

3. When done successfully, an alert box should pop up signifying the registry of the DLL was successful.



Once this DLL is registered, you may open UltraSite32 and begin using it.
